RE - ACCESS TO NMIT KYNETON PARK DURING NMIT KYNETON CUP WEEK

1) SAND TRACK ACCESS

The sand track will be open on the following dates and time during NMIT Melbourne Cup week

- Saturday 29th Oct - 5am to 10am
- Sunday 30th Oct - 7am to 9am
- Monday 31st Oct - 5am to 10am
- Tuesday 1st Nov - 5am to 10am
- Wed 2nd Nov - CLOSED
- Thursday 3rd Nov - 5am to 10am
- Friday 4th Nov - 5am to 7.45am
- Saturday 5th Nov - 5am to 10am
- Sunday 6th Nov - Closed

2) GRASS TRACK ACCESS

Access will be provided to the grass via request to Steve Schmidt 0407 615 046 for horses entered for NMIT Kyneton Cup Day or races at Flemington ONLY and opening of this grass is subject to weather and track conditions.

- Saturday 29th Oct - 5am to 10am - Local Horses nominated for NMIT Kyneton Cup Day or Flemington (out wide)
- Sunday 30th Oct - CLOSED
- Monday 31st Oct - 5am to 10am - Local Horses nominated for NMIT Kyneton Cup Day or Flemington (out wide)
- Tuesday 1st Nov - CLOSED
- Wed 2nd Nov - CLOSED
- Thursday 3rd Nov - CLOSED
- Friday 4th Nov - 5am to 7.45am - Local Horses (rail)
- Saturday 5th Nov - CLOSED
- Sunday 6th Nov - CLOSED

3) JUMP OUTS

- Nominations for the above jumps outs will close on Tuesday 1st Nov (Melb Cup Day) at 12 noon.
- Jump outs will start from the 800mt mark - 1200mt jumps outs will be allowed for providing we receive at least 5 nominations. If less than 5 nominations are received these horse will be relocated to an 800mt jump out.
- Race day colours must be worn by riders requiring a barrier certificate/racing approval.
- Trainers are encouraged to have all riders wearing race day colours as the jump outs will be filmed and placed on our web site within 48 hours of the jump outs. Visit kyneton.countryracing.com.au and click on the owner's trainer's icon on the left hand side of the web page to view the jump outs.
- Jump outs may be cancelled due to poor weather or due to the state of the track. If cancelled, a text message will be sent out.
- No persons under the age of 18 years of age are permitted within the horse movement areas (Float Park, horse stalls, horse paths, wash bays, sand rolls or tracks) during training and racing hours unless they are a Racing Victoria Official or a Licensed Person. This clause is in line with Racing Victoria's On – Course Horse Movement Policy. Trainers should do all they reasonably can to notify and make their owners aware of this requirement.
- The Club and Racing Victoria require the following information when nominating a horse for a Jump Outs.
