PRACTICE BARRIERS FOR SALE X 2

The Kyneton & Hanging Rock Racing Club have two old sets of second hand practice barriers (6 gates) for sale. Both sets of barriers are over 25 years old and no longer meet modern standards and the Club has new modern barriers on order.

The first set of barriers for sale (Sand Track) is the barriers that up until yesterday were out on the main sand track and in operation. These barriers for the purpose of sale will be known as the Sand Track Barriers which are in average condition. The second set of barriers will be known as the Campaspe Barriers and these barriers are in poor condition and have not been used for many years and will require significant work to return them to suitable condition for future use.

Attached are a couple of photos of each set of barriers for background information and each set of barriers can be viewed in the Bus Car park located to the left of the main entry gate. Should you be interested in purchasing either of these barriers then the following terms & conditions will apply.

- Any offer to purchase must be made to the Business Development Manager (Simon Buckley) by either e-mail (simon.buckley@countryracing.com.au) or via letter (PO Box 106, Kyneton, 3444) by no later than 5pm, Friday 5th August 2011.
- The Club will consider all reasonable offers made to purchase the barriers whether it's for cash or in kind.
- All bidders agree to view the barriers in advance of making a bid and to make themselves fully aware of the condition of these barriers and acknowledge that varying levels of works are required to each set of barriers to return them to modern standards.
- The bidder agrees that if their bid is successful, they will pay the Club the agreed fee prior to the removal of the barriers from site.
- On notification of a successful bidder, the purchaser agrees to pay the agreed fee and remove either or both barriers from site within 21 days of being informed that their bid was successful.
- The Club may withdraw the items for sale at any time it wishes between now and 5pm on the 5th August 2011.
- If no bids have been received by the 5th August 2011, the Club will sell the barriers for scrap metal
