Topic: Reopening of Grass Track

As your aware NMIT Kyneton Park has faced some significant challenges over the last 4 months due to damages sustained to our training and racing infrastructure by the Storms and Floods in January. We are able to advise that the grass will reopen next week subject to weather conditions.

As the grass has only recently recovered from the damages sustained and we are about to head in to winter the Club will be taking a conservative approach in managing access to the grass over the next few months to ensure our race meetings can proceed on "fit for purpose" racing surface.

You need to be aware that the Grass Gallop/Jump Out Schedule below is "Subject to Change" and the club will be reassessing the availability of the grass on a week by week basis which could result in either a decrease or increase access depending on weather and track conditions.

We understand the need and importance for trainers to access the grass and will do what we reasonably can to provide access, however we need to all keep in mind that it is our Race Day operation that ensures our ongoing sustainability and therefore being able to conduct our race meetings must be our first priority.

The schedules below are based on us receiving favourable weather conditions and has been formulated to assist trainers with planning out their training needs for May 2011. The schedule for June will be released in late May.

Grass Gallops

The grass track at NMIT Kyneton Park will be open for grass gallops on the following dates and times during May subject to weather and track conditions.

Date	Times	Whom	Conditions
Thur 12 th May	0500 to 1000	Local Trainers Only	Outside Grass - Nominated Horses Only
Thur 19 th May	0500 to 1000	Local Trainers Only	Outside Grass - Nominated Horses Only
Wed 25 th May	0500 to 0745	Local Trainers Only	Full Access

Jump Outs

Jump Outs will be held on site on the following dates and times subject to weather and track conditions.

Date	Times	Whom	Conditions
Tue 10 th May	0800 to Finish	Local Trainers Only	Nominated horses only and those seeking a certificate to race, Maximum 6 horses per trainer.
Wed 25 th May	0800 to Finish	Local Trainers Only	All Horses

Important Information:

- Please note the grass will not open for Jump Outs or Grass Gallops if the track is rated heavy and if this was to occur you will be notified via text.
- There will be no access to the grass track for gallops prior to the jump outs on the 10th May.

- **Nominations for the Jumps Out on this Tuesday (10th May) will close tomorrow at 2pm.**
- To nominate a horse for a jump out please contact either the Track Work Supervisor or the Club on 5422 1866 or e-mail m.graham@countryracing.com.au
- All Jump outs will start from the 800mt mark for Tuesday 10th May (no 1200mt jump outs)
- Race day colours are to be worn by riders requiring racing certificate
- The Club and RVL require the following information when nominating a horse for the Jump Outs.
