

Racing Industry Mandatory Training for Stablehands NMIT Kyneton Park – 10 & 17 June

From **1 August 2011**, all Registered Stablehands must have completed the mandatory Stablehand skill-set comprising two nationally accredited units from the Racing Industry Training Package:

- Handle Horses (RGRPSH201A)
- Follow OHS Procedures and Observe Environmental Work Practices (RGRCMN201A)

Completion of the skill-set is designed to provide Stablehands with the necessary skills and knowledge to work in the Racing Industry.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Existing Stablehands may fast track their training by undertaking the RPL process which allows for a demonstration of knowledge and skills through an evidence-based procedure conducted by the training provider.

Training delivery and RPLs

NMIT (Northern Melbourne Institute of TAFE) is an RVL Preferred Provider and will deliver the mandatory training and RPLs at NMIT Kyneton Park on the following dates and times:

- **Friday 10 June – 10.00 am to 3.00 pm**
- **Friday 17 June – 10.00 am to 3.00 pm**
